

“SAKSHAM NIVESHAK”
(Second 100-Days Campaign - from 1st April 2026 to 9th July 2026)

The Investor Education and Protection Fund Authority (“IEPFA”), under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“MCA”), has, vide its intimation dated 27th March 2026, advised companies to undertake a **Second 100 Days Campaign titled “Saksham Niveshak”** to reach out to shareholders whose dividends remain unpaid or unclaimed.
